### CLEAR CREEK BAPTIST BIBLE COLLEGE SHOPPING SPREE 2014

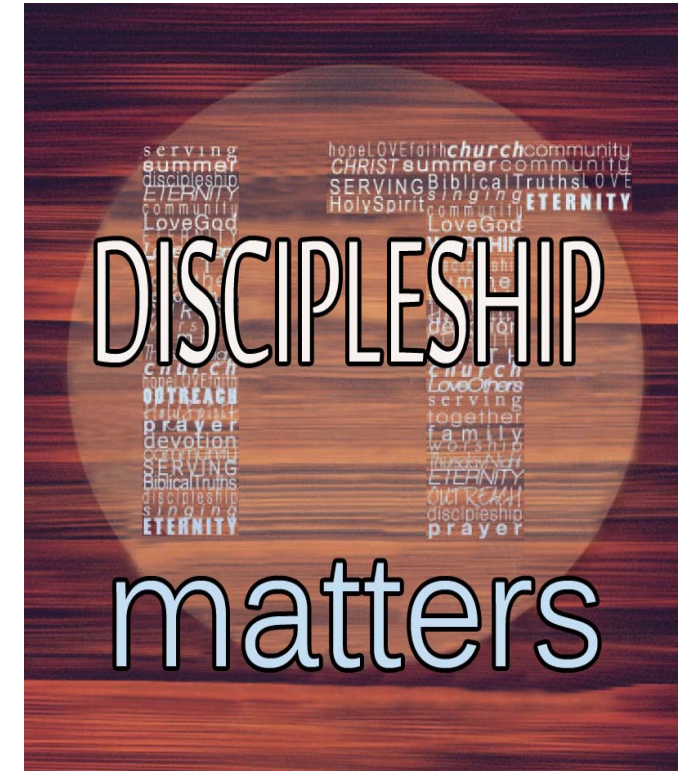
