**Weekdays** – When Bullitt County schools are closed due to inclement weather, the church office and CLC will open at 10:00 a.m.

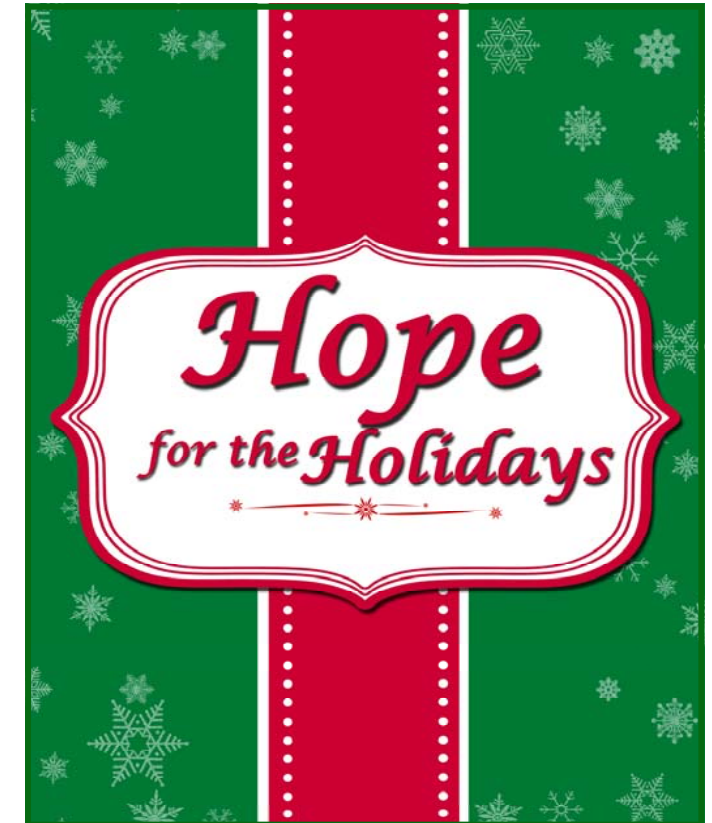
**Wednesdays** – When Bullitt County schools are closed due to inclement weather, there will be no Wednesday evening activities, including prayer meeting.
