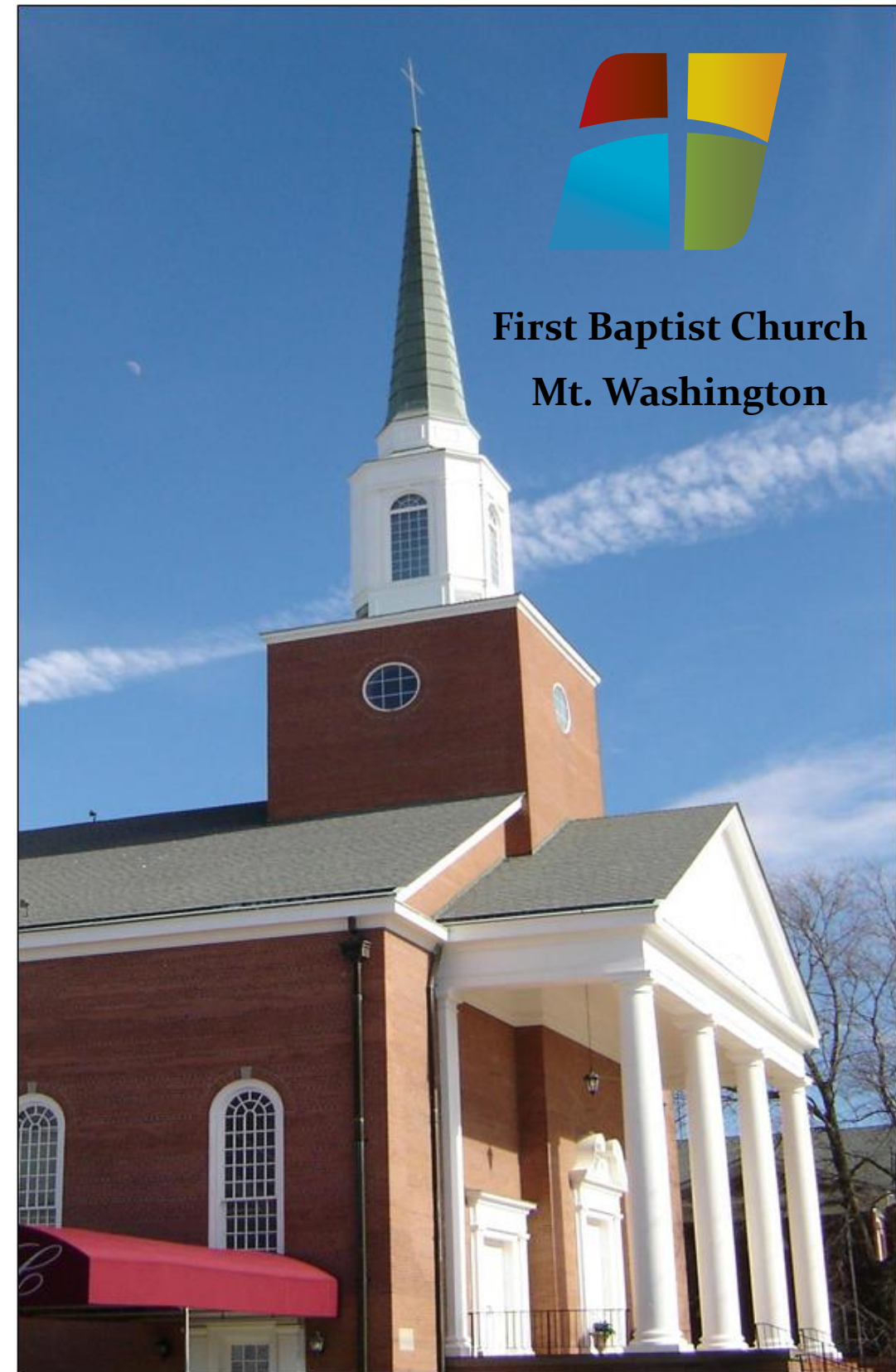
Jim Castlen, Senior Adult Minister
