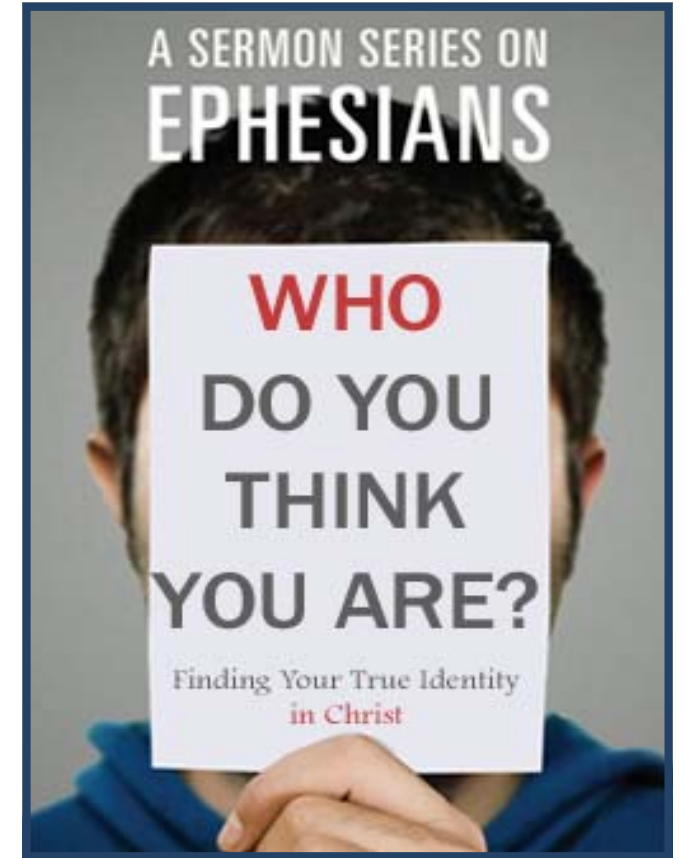

1. New \_\_\_\_\_ — The change that takes place is so deep that the Bible describes it as being "born again," a term that comes from Jesus' conversation with Nicodemus (John 3:3-7). A sign that we have experienced new birth is that we are craving the nourishment of Scripture.

2. New \_\_\_\_\_ — Sin no longer dominates those who are regenerated. They have a new life with God and a new Lord who sits on the throne of their hearts. All previous false lords have been dethroned.

3. New \_\_\_\_\_ — Sin comes from our hearts. When we are born again, the desire of our hearts change and we have new hearts that are focused on the things of God.
