JESUS ALONE: HE OVERCAME DEATH

Matthew 28:1-17; I Corinthians 15:1-6

ACCOUNTS.

“...Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that He was buried, that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures”
(1 Cor. 15:3-4 NIV).

“After that, he appeared to more than five hundred of the brothers and sisters at the same time, most of whom are still living, though some have fallen asleep” (vs. 6 NIV).

TOMB.

“The angel said to the women ... He is not here, He is risen, just as He said. Come and see the place where He lay. Then go quickly and tell His disciples: He has risen from the dead ...” (Matt. 28:5-7 NIV).

WITNESSES.

“So the women hurried away from the tomb ... suddenly Jesus met them. Greetings ... then the eleven disciples went to Galilee ... When they saw Him, they worshipped Him” (Matt. 28:8-9, 6-17 NIV).

“For we know that since Christ was raised from the dead, he cannot die again; death no longer has mastery over him” (Rom. 6:9 NIV).

“Jesus said to her, “I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die; and whoever lives by believing in me will never die. Do you believe this” (John 11:25-26 NIV).
