Dr. Ray Hicks, Associate Pastor, Member Care and leaders from Severns Valley Baptist Church will lead the meeting. This meeting is for anyone interested in being a part of a CR Ministry. We are making plans to begin this ministry here at FBC perhaps by late summer or early fall.

Celebrate Recovery is a Christ-centered recovery program based on the Beatitudes. It is currently being used in over 12,000 churches nationwide, and internationally. Since 1991, over 10,000 people have gone through the program at Saddleback Church addressing many of life's hurts, habits, and hang-ups.

Celebrate Recovery meets 52 weeks a year, providing a large group teaching time of life changing lessons and open share breakout groups where participants are invited to share openly about their struggles and victories.
