UNDER RENOVATION

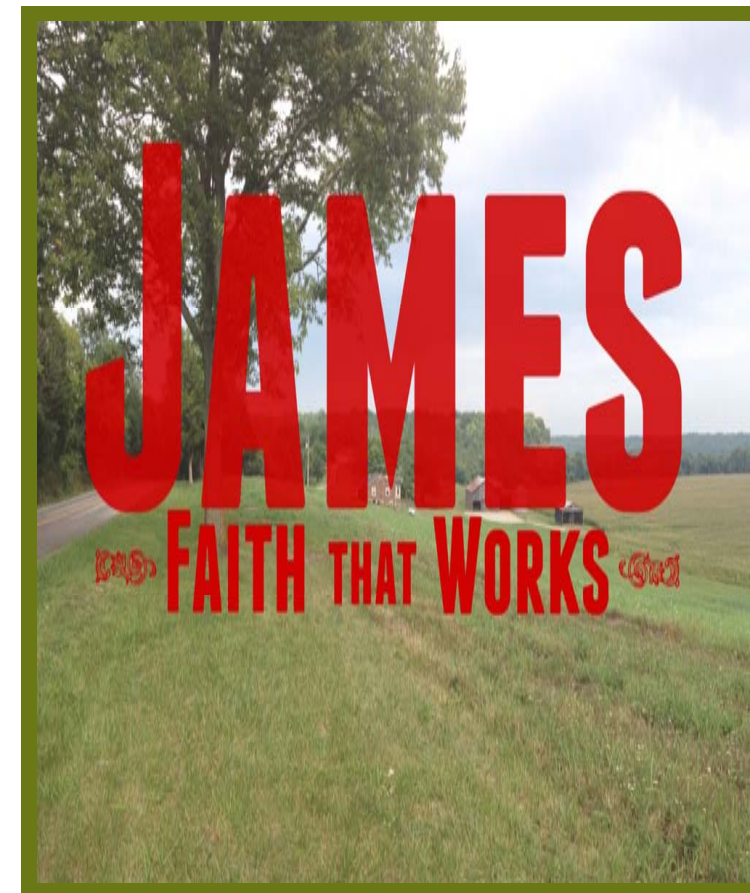
Please note that the restroom located in the hallway just behind the choir loft will be closed from July 6 - July 19 for renovation.
