Recommendation from Personnel Committee For Minister to Senior Adults

The Personnel Committee is pleased to recommend Dr. Jim Castlen to the part-time position as Minister to Senior Adults at First Baptist Church. He is married to Shelby Jean, and they have two children, Tim and Heather.

Jim is a graduate of Berea College, New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary, and The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary. While a doctoral student at Southern Seminary, he served as Minister of Music with our church family from 1980 to 1984 and taught courses at Boyce College. He also served 12 years as Professor of Music and Missions at Clear Creek Bible College in Pineville, Kentucky. Jim and Shelby Jean were appointed as missionaries with the International Mission Board at the Philippine Baptist Theological Seminary in 1971.

In December, 2013, Jim retired after serving as Director of Missions for the Three Forks Baptist Association in southeastern Kentucky from August, 2002 through December, 2013.

After conversations and an interview meeting with the Personnel Committee, Jim has agreed to move to our area while he serves as our Minister to Senior Adults.
