A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

"I LOVE MY CHURCH" SMALL GROUP STUDIES

Beginning Sunday, August 30, our Adult Sunday School classes and small groups will be focusing on the "I Love My Church" studies. These studies are a back-to-the-basics review of what it means to be a growing follower of Christ. 
