## A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

### "I LOVE MY CHURCH" SMALL GROUP STUDIES

**Beginning Sunday, August 30**, our Adult Sunday School classes and small groups will be focusing on the "I Love My Church" studies. These studies are a back-to-the-basics review of what it means to be a growing follower of Christ. The first four weeks deal with what it means to be a Christian and how we relate to the church, the body of Christ; the second four weeks concern habits that a maturing believer needs to develop in his/her spiritual life; and the last four weeks look at giftedness and finding a ministry in the life of the church.

We want as many people as possible to go through these studies, so we are providing several options:

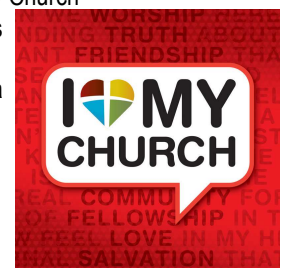
- If you **currently attend** a class/small group, your group will study these lessons.

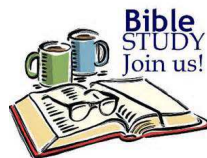
