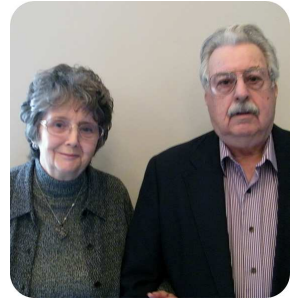

ANNIE ARMSTRONG EASTER OFFERING

What is the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering?

In 1895, the first missions offering to benefit the work of the home missions (now known as North American missions) was promoted and taken up by the Woman's Missionary Union (WMU.) The Home Mission Board (now known as the North American Mission Board) asked for \$5000 toward its work. WMU efforts exceeded that goal. From that start to today, more than \$1 billion has been raised for North American mission efforts. Every dollar of the offering (named after advocate and WMU leader, Annie Armstrong in 1934) goes to missionaries and their work of sharing the life-transforming gospel of Jesus Christ throughout the United States, Canada, and their territories.

First Baptist Mt Washington has long been a part of giving to this offering. This year is no different. Prayerfully consider what your gift to reach the lost in North America will be. **FBC goal is \$ 12,500.**
