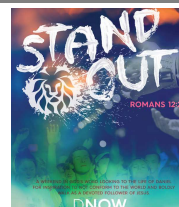

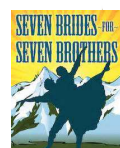

WINTER WEATHER POLICY

Our closing policy during inclement weather is as follows:

Sundays - Our goal is to hold services even when the weather is bad, except for unusual weather conditions such as ice.
