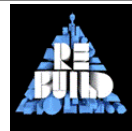

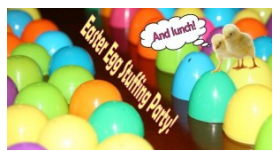
## EASTER NEEDS
