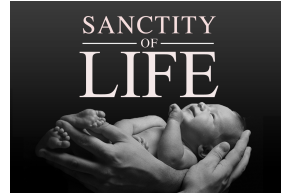

MEN'S WEDNESDAY BIBLE STUDY

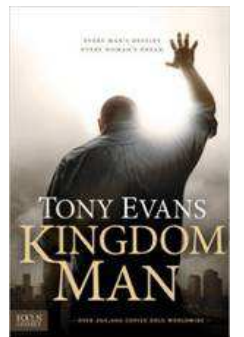

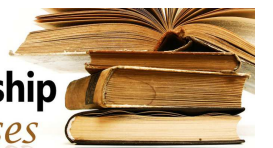

- * **ONWARD** (6 weeks, Cameron Ford)—How can the church speak to social and political issues with a bigger vision in mind: that of the gospel of Jesus Christ?
