In fact, your faithfulness in giving through the summer months allow our financial office to be better financial stewards of our expenses.

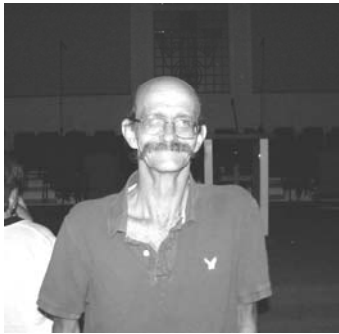
