Dear First Baptist Family,

You have blessed our church with your tithes and offerings for the first half of 2015! I can't thank you enough for your generous support of First Baptist Church and its ever-increasing ministries. We want to offer sincere appreciation to you for investing in our church while honoring God with your finances. You are asked to pick up your mid-year contribution statement on Sunday July 26 or August 2.

The first half of 2015 has been a significant time for success in ministry. Some of the many ways your generosity has made this possible are listed below:

- We demonstrated a servant's heart by sending and financially supporting mission teams to Atlanta, Eastern Kentucky, inner-city Louisville and Scotland.
- We helped fulfill The Great Commission by contributing approximately \$67,755.51 to the Cooperative Program which supports over 5,000 North American and 5,000 International Missionaries.
- We continue to contribute to the ongoing ministry of Mercy Hill church plant in the amount of \$2,750 each month.
- We were able to call a Minister to Senior Adults, Dr. Jim Castlen, and Worship Pastor, Dr. Marc Brown.

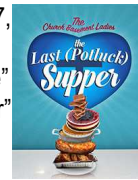
