Plan now to attend our first meeting of "Wednesday Evenings with the Psalms" on June 24 at 6:15 p.m. in Coakley Chapel.

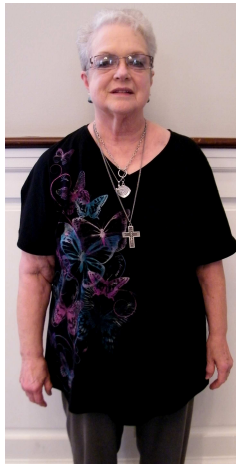
