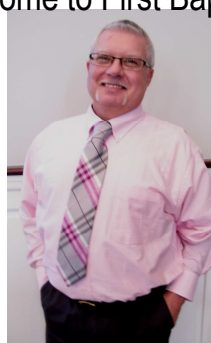

**BULLITT COUNTY HOMELESS CAN NOW FIND 'ROOM IN THE INN'**

First Baptist Church has agreed to participate in a pilot program, **Heart of My City**, for two months. Room in the Inn serves "guests" (participating homeless persons) who are emotionally stable, not currently affected by drugs or alcohol, and willing to abide by the rules of the program, which prohibit drinking, smoking in the building, weapons, drugs, fighting and foul language or abuse, ensuring a safe environment for the other guests and the faith community volunteers.

Our church provides a warm place, food, fellowship, and safe sleeping quarters. The guests will be met by a team of fully trained volunteers who will prepare an evening meal, spend the evening connecting together (playing board games, etc.), spend the night, and prepare breakfast, before being returned to the initial pick-up point around 6:00 a.m.
