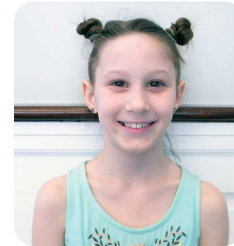

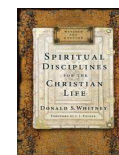
**CHURCH-WIDE YARD SALE**
