FUNERAL MEAL MINISTRY**FUNERAL MEAL MINISTRY**

For years, our church has provided funeral-day meals for the families of members who have passed away. It is a much-appreciated gesture for grieving families. The ministry has been completely volunteer-based, from the meal coordinator to those who cook and provide food. At times, there may be only one funeral a month, or there may be three in one week. The meals may involve 15-20 people or 80-100 people.

Ideally, Sunday School classes should be the first point of ministry and should help provide for their class members' families, and many do help out. Still, many members are not part of Sunday School class but still need help with the funeral meals.

Several of our meal coordinators and many meal providers have become overworked and have had to step away from the ministry. In order to continue, we must have additional volunteer help. We need people who would be willing to coordinate the meals—to call volunteers for dishes, and to help serve and clean up afterwards. Training is available. We also need more volunteers who would be able to provide and deliver dishes for the meals.

We are at the point of only being able to offer our facilities to grieving families, with the expectation that the family and friends would provide food and volunteers for the meal.

We need your help to continue this ministry! If you would be willing and able to help coordinate these meals at times (perhaps on a monthly basis) or if you would be willing to help provide dishes for meals, please contact Donna Lieber at 538-7361.
