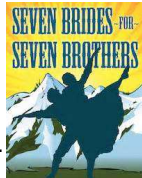

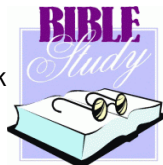

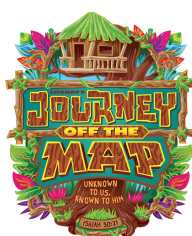
VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL - June 15-19, 2015 JOURNEY OFF THE MAP
