A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

Dr. Marcus Brown, Candidate for Minister of Music

The Personnel Committee is delighted to recommend to First Baptist Church Dr. Marcus Brown as Minister of Music. Presently, Dr. Brown (Marc) is serving in his thirteenth year as Minister of Music with Grace Baptist Church in Woodbridge, Virginia. In fulfilling this role, Marc plans and leads multiple worship services in contemporary and traditional styles. Also, he directs his ministry through leading a worship band, vocal teams, choir, adult choral ensemble, orchestra, brass and wind ensembles, and drama. In addition, he supervises a Media Director and Tech Team along with the Children's Choir Coordinator, Music Librarian, Drama Director, Volunteer Worship Leaders, Pianist, Organist, Visual Art Coordinator, and Summer Worship Intern. Marc's previous ministry positions include Bowling Green, Kentucky; Oakland, Kentucky; and Greenwood, Indiana.



In 1993, Marc graduated from Western Kentucky University with a Bachelor of Arts in Music with a major in Voice and Music Education. He graduated from The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary with a Master of Church Music (1996) with an emphasis in conducting, vocal performance and church music drama. In 2014, he graduated from The Robert E. Webber Institute for Worship Studies with a Doctor of Worship Studies. He was ordained in 1996 by the Oakland Baptist Church, Oakland, KY.

Marc is married to Cynthia (Cyndi) Grice Brown, and they have a daughter, Miriam (Age 4). Cyndi teaches fifth grade at the Prince William County Public Schools as a National Board Certified Teacher. She is also a graduate of WKU.
