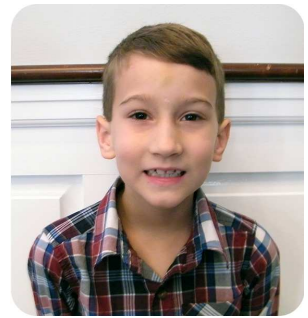


PICK-A-TREE STAR
