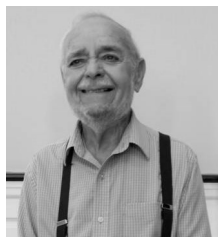

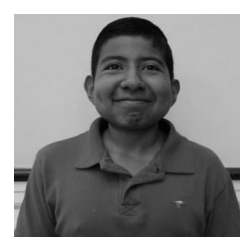

MISSIONS MINISTRY

THE HEART OF THE STORY-CREATIVE MINISTRIES

Creative Ministries Festival 2.0 is a two-day worship experience that equips students to share the gospel in creative ways. The event includes classes in various aspects of creative ministries such as puppets, balloons, interpretive movement, sign, "God Rods," skits, juggling, face painting, magic, lip synch, clowning and human video.

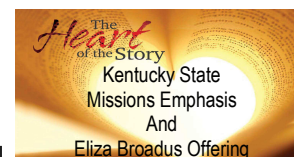
New elements have been added to Creative Ministries Festival 2.0 to take this event to the next level in missions. First, a practical application component in the form of block parties (which may be indoor events due to weather) was added to allow students an opportunity to perform, mingle with the crowds, and see creative ministries in use to share the gospel.

To prepare students for personal evangelism, an additional element of CMF 2.0 is the requirement that every participant attend a workshop on sharing the gospel. Participants are first challenged to confirm their own relationship with Christ and then to share Jesus as they use creative arts in missions.
