### THE HEART OF THE STORY-TELL YOUR STORY

She was a Muslim student at a Kentucky university and listened to a testimony on the website [tellyourstory.today](http://tellyourstory.today). Now she is a believer in the Lord Jesus. Through the simple act of sharing stories, Kentucky Baptists are reaching thousands of people with the gospel. In fact the website had so many visitors, that it collapsed and had to be completely redone to handle the volume of traffic.

Tell Your Story is as easy as one-two-three-four. 1) Visit the website and call the toll-free number listed to record your story. 2) Press 1 and follow the instructions. 3) A text message will be sent to you (usually within 24 hours) when your story is posted in the "Stories" area. 4) Share your story with others. You can post a link to your story on social media, send an e-card to a friend, or print cards with the web address of your story that you can give to people you meet. Every time someone listens to your story, you will get a text message letting you know that someone has listened. Tell your Story so others may know and become a Christ follower like this student. And give to the Eliza Broadus Offering for State Missions...an offering that helps to share the HEART OF THE STORY.
