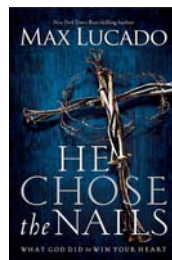
VALENTINE BRUNCH-SPARATION *RESCHEDULED*
